"The hotels provide hospitality servic-es (including protein-heavy regional meals, thrice a day) and have been trained on the bygiene and cleaning pro-tocol developed by a team of infectious disease doctors at Apollo", adds Tejasvi. The medical supervision is done by the partnering hospital: "We have a tech platform that enables teleconsultation

with doctors, and once the prescription is generated, our pharmacy and diagnos-tic teams make sure it is delivered." Apart from this, nurses (one for every 20 beds) and ward boys are stationed at the hotel 24/7, along with a doctor to come in and check on the patient every day. In select hotels, oxygen cylinders and concentrators are kept on standby in case the situation deteriorates, and the patient needs to be moved to the partner hospital.
