I. Construction Phase

I.	Construction should be started after obtaining prior Consent to Establish from Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC) under Air and Water Acts and a copy shall be submitted to the SEAC-Delhi, failing which project shall be discontinued. II. 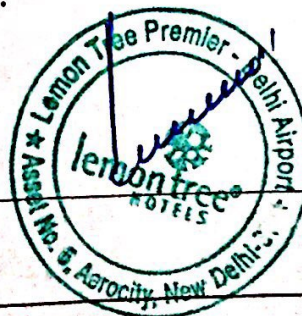

VII. 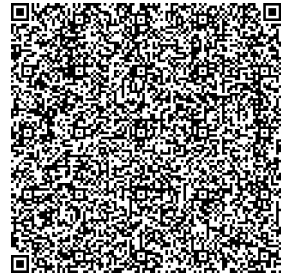

The garbage being generated from the above institutions/ organizations is being disposed/ collected by the unauthorized garbage pickers, which is being throw/dump it into the forest area/green belt or at the road & drain side, wherever they found feasible, which become the cause of nuisance i.e. hazardous to public as well as spoiling the environment thus going the violation of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal.

7. The waste collector will dump the residual waste free of cost at the designated site by the local body only. Thus, No claim will be consider in any Court of Law

Note: The aforementioned T & C are extendable time to time under the direction of the authorities.
