



The DG sets of capacity more than 1000 KVA should be provided the stipulated stack height of 30 meter from the ground. If not possible due to any reason, permission from MoEF must be obtained specifically for stack height of such DG sets. All the DG sets should be subjected to periodic noise and stack monitoring in consultation with DPCC. Waste/used diesel should be stored and managed as per Hazardous (Management and Handling) 2000 as amended to date and be sold to CPCB approved recyclers, Clearance from AAI should be obtained for stack height of D.G set.

DG sets has been installed as per stipulated condition and run only during the power failure.

However in view of order from DPCC (order no. DPCC/RDPC/DG Set Directions/2017/5118-5135 Dated: 18/10/2017) regarding operation of DG sets, the use of DG sets has been stopped from 18/10/2017 and it will not be operated till 15/03/2018. During this period other sources of power backup will be used for such as emergency lights in corridors, all stairs cases & basements are in inverters and server & exchange are on UPS.

Lemon Tree focuses on delivering a healthy 'triple bottom line' i.e. Planet, People and Profit through its sustainability initiatives.

1. 
