Located in the Balaghat district of Madhya Pradesh, this eco-friendly resort is nestled within the buffer zone of Kanha National Park, offering a true jungle experience. Lemon Tree Wildlife Resort, Kanha is a paradise for wildlife enthusiasts and adventure seekers. This resort is equipped with cottages and villas that blend into the landscape, offering an intimate connection with nature, and providing the perfect setting for guests to take a digital detox. The resort is within the Kanha National Park which is spread over 2,140 square kilometres and is the second largest national park of Madhya Pradesh.

Kanha National Park is popular for its exciting wildlife safaris during which one can spot tigers, leopards, sloth bears and different varieties of deer like barasingha, sambar, spotted deer etc. Soak in the serene environs of the place, admire the rich flora and fauna, focus your binoculars on rare birds, enjoy a short walk at sunset across a lantern-lit path through the dense forest up to a small pond or embark on a thrilling ride through the dense jungle on a safari arranged by the property, the choice is yours.

This refreshingly different wildlife resort has a leisurely ambience with contemporary interiors, natural wooden textures and ample greens, coupled with warm and friendly service. The resort encourages guests to engage with nature and wildlife without the distractions of technology. It comprises 15 comfortable cottages and spacious villas, along with Citrus Café – a multi-cuisine coffee shop, a bar (to be opened in the second phase) and a refreshing swimming pool, the resort brings the outdoors in making it the perfect place to relax and unwind with family and friends.

Local Activities

The hotel can organise several activities, including:

- Jungle Safari: The resort can book a standard morning/evening safari in a comfortable Gypsy with a trained naturalist cum driver.
- Sundowner Picnic at the Banjaar River: Guests can be driven in a Gypsy to the Banjaar River where a beautiful picnic setup with table and chairs awaits them. The resort can arrange coffee, tea, cold beverages, alcoholic beverages (subject to regulations), snacks, and a bonfire at the location.
- Nature Trail: Enjoy the forests on foot! Walk amongst the lush dense Sal forests along the Banjaar river enjoying serene views along with our naturalist and guide to get up close with macro flora and fauna
- Night Patrolling: Often called as the night safari, one can explore the forest at late evening-night. The night patrolling happens in the buffer areas of the Kanha National Park and guests can experience the mysteries of the jungle in the dark. The safari is explored in jeeps between 7pm to 10pm
- Arts & Crafts: Art enthusiasts can also get their hands dirty with pottery sessions, gond painting workshops and dance to the tunes of Baiga Tribal Dance under starry evenings
